The Trondenes peninsula has had great historical importance, both locally and nationally. Once a seat for a great Viking Chieftain, and later of strategic significance for the occupants during WWII. It was also a starting point for the christening of Norway and Trondenes church was one of the wealthiest in the country. The tour starts at the pier and goes by bus to Trondenes after a short city sightseeing.
